FUNDING

Funding for each vocational qualification delivered by TAFE Queensland for the FNQ Vocational Academy program is available through the Vocational Education and Training in Schools (VETiS) program, funded by the Queensland Government. Eligibility criteria applies.

If you are currently undertaking or have already completed a certificate II qualification you may not be eligible to access funding. Full fees may apply.

TIMETABLES

- Semester 1 students attend FNQ Vocational Academy at the TAFE Queensland Cairns campus three days per week, one day vocational training, and one day allocated as work experience placement.
- Semester 2, 3 and 4 students attend FNQ Vocational Academy at the TAFE Queensland Cairns campus two days per week, one day vocational training, and two days allocated as work experience placement.
- This program is delivered in conjunction with mentoring opportunities, career education, health and wellbeing programs, industry engagement, and financial literacy to develop resilient and ready workers.
- School subjects are timetabled around work experience placement so as to not conflict with class time. This ensures a smooth transition from school to work.
