



Frequently Asked Questions

<p>What kind of computer is required?</p>	<p>Please refer to our Device Specifications document.</p>
<p>What if I already own a laptop, iPad, MacBook or Android Tablet?</p>	<p>To ensure the device can be connected to our network, the device must meet the minimum specifications. Please see the Device Specifications document.</p>
<p>Will I be able to charge my device at school?</p>	<p>The charging of devices will need to be undertaken at home as a general task in preparation for school. Most modern devices, managed properly, will last a full day if completely charged at the beginning of the day.</p>
<p>Will parents/carers be recommended to purchase insurance?</p>	<p>The school highly recommends that the device is insured in its own right or specifically with an existing insurance policy.</p>
<p>Will students/parents be recommended to purchase a protective case.</p>	<p>It is highly recommended that all devices are kept in a protective case for security reasons and to avoid damage.</p>
<p>What happens if another student damages the device?</p>	<p>While the school will deal with inappropriate behaviour in line with existing policies, the school is not liable for any damage or replacement costs incurred while the device is at school.</p>
<p>Who is responsible for the device if damaged at school?</p>	<p>The student is responsible for the safe-keeping and protection of their device.</p>
<p>Who will be responsible for warranty and repairs?</p>	<p>Parents/guardians are responsible for the repair of the device.</p>
<p>What if the device is stolen?</p>	<p>The school's best advice for device safety is for students to keep their device with them at all times. Students will be disciplined where evidence supports a finding of theft of a device within the school. While all reasonable steps will be taken to recover property, the school has no liability for any financial loss incurred.</p>
<p>Will the school be able to guide parents on the best device to purchase?</p>	<p>The school's advice lies in the minimum specification list. Consideration should also be given to the student's lifestyle, interests, capabilities, chosen subjects and levels of responsibility when making their device choice.
